Medication while at camp

A Medication Permission Form must be completed for all medications, including over-the-counter, your child will need to take while at camp.

- **Only medicines with a completed and signed form will be administered.**
- All medicines **MUST** be checked in with FCC Camp Nurse.
- Children will not be allowed to keep or administer their own medication.

Two Medication Permission forms are included with this packet.

- Complete and turn in with registration forms for any medications your child takes daily as of now.
- We can update as needed prior to camp.

Money

What to Bring

- ❑ Bible & Pen
- ❑ 6 pairs of shorts (*No "short shorts". Stand with you arms by your side—your shorts should be longer than your fingertips.*)
- ❑ 6 T-shirts (*No spaghetti strap tank tops or midriff tops*)
- ❑ Underwear
- ❑ Sock & tennis shoes for recreation (*2 pairs of closed toed shoes would be ideal*)
- ❑ One-piece swimsuits (*No bikinis, tankinis, or T-shirts over two-piece swimsuits*)
- ❑ Beach towel
- ❑ Sunscreen (*Only if your child has an allergy or sensitivity - FCC will provide traditional spray sunscreen for all campers*)
- ❑ Towels & Washcloths
- ❑ Bed Linens (*for XL twin bed*) or sleeping bag & pillow
- ❑ Shampoo, conditioner, soap, and/or shower gel
- ❑ Shower shoes (*flip flops*)
- ❑ Deodorant
- ❑ Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- ❑ Spending money for fast food to/from camp, snacks, T-shirts, CDs, etc (*We recommend no more than \$30. It must be turned in to FCC counselors at check-in.*)
- ❑ Backpack or other bag to carry belongings
- ❑ Water Bottle (***THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!***)
- ❑ Any necessary prescription or over the counter medication as listed on Health Form (*All medications must be turned in to FCC Camp Nurse/Director at check-in.*)
 - * *Your child will have to move/carry their own belongings , so pack as light as possible.*
 - * *We recommend packing each set of clothes in a Ziploc bag labelled with the day.*
 - * *Please make sure to pack clothes that can get messy.*

What NOT to Bring

- ⊗ Cellphones, iPods, video games, etc (No electronics are allowed while at camp)
- ⊗ Tobacco, drugs, or alcohol
- ⊗ Weapons or pocket knives
- ⊗ Fireworks
- ⊗ Water Balloons
- ⊗ Lighters, matches, or candles

2019 Track Descriptions

- Lego My Lego – Do you love Legos? I mean, REALLY love them? This is the track for you! Build your very own Legoland of awesomeness.
- Taking the Stage – Put your acting skills to the test! Play drama games and create your own characters using costumes and theatrical makeup.
- Game On! – If you're a sports fan, you belong HERE! Get your GAME ON by playing soccer, kickball, baseball, and more.
- Dance, Dance Baby – Learn all the latest dances and even make up your own little number. You'll get to record a music video to share with the entire camp!
- Arty Party – Ready to get creative and make your own masterpiece? Use paint, markers, and colored pencils to create your own work of art.
- Crash! Bang! Splat! – Become a scientist and do some pretty cool experiments that might require safety goggles! (Shhh! Don't tell mom!)
- FGO (For Girls Only) – NO BOYS ALLOWED! This track is for the girliest girly girls around! Think nail polish, flowers, lace, beads, and lots more!
- H2O YEAH – These games and activities are all about water! You'll play some water games, maybe do a water experiment or two, either way, you'll definitely get wet! You might want to bring a towel for the walk back to your dorm.
- Xtreme Challenge – Ever want to see if you have what it takes to cross the finish line? See if you're up for the challenge in this track by completing the obstacle course in record time, win at Capture the Flag, and reign as King of the Hill.
